 - A mesmerizing photograph that captures both elegance and mystery, "Inner Circle" reflects the timeless beauty of natural forms in a way that feels both contemporary and eternal.
- Second Place: As Darkness Fell by Pamela Moore
 (Montclair, NJ)
 Moore's evocative image conveys the shifting interplay
 between light and shadow, where botanical subjects take on
 a mood both haunting and lyrical.
- Third Place: Untitled #54 by Joseph Gattulli (Plainview, NY)
 Gattulli's work offers a bold exploration of composition and
 tonality, inviting viewers to see the flora of the world as both
 subject and abstraction.

- Meadow Daydream by Juleah Claar (Waedenswil, Switzerland)
- Debut by KM Smith (Solana Beach, CA)
